Initial Planning

The partners met in Nicosia, Cyprus for the 1st Transnational Meeting and Partner Workshop of the project.

As a kick-off point, they agreed on the project management plan and they defined the learning outcomes for all the 15 competencies of ENTRECOMP and 6 out of the 8 competencies of ERF.



Material Development

The partners started working on creating training materials on ENTRECOMP, which resulted in 15 training courses of 80 hours in total. To provide more opportunities for learners, the materials created in English were translated into Arabic and Greek.



Material Review and Refinement

The partners met in Larissa, Greece for the 2nd Transnational Meeting and the 1st Training of Master Trainers of the project, where they presented and reviewed all the materials that had been created. Considering the project plan, the project timeline and the upcoming stages of the project were discussed, including the development of courses on ERF and the conversion of the ENTRECOMP courses into asynchronous ones.
