

Activity MT1.3_2: "Lost in Translation"

Objective:

To demonstrate how tone, body language, and cultural context can change the meaning of words and how language can impact perceptions.

Duration:

10-15 Minutes

Instructions:

- 1. **Pair Up Participants**: Divide participants into pairs and give each pair a simple, neutral sentence (e.g., "I can't believe you did that!" or "That's interesting!").
- 2. **Assign Emotions/Tones**: Ask each pair to say the sentence multiple times, each with a different assigned tone or emotion, such as:
 - Surprise
 - Sarcasm
 - Disappointment
 - Excitement
- 3. **Body Language Variation**: Next, have each participant add body language or facial expressions to match their tone, like crossing arms or using exaggerated hand gestures.
- 4. **Debrief**: After each pair performs, ask the group how the changes in tone and body language affected the perceived meaning. Discuss how subtle shifts can completely alter how a message is received.

This activity **MT1.3_2** is both lighthearted and insightful, showing how the same words can mean very different things depending on delivery.
