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## Activity Title: MT3.1\_6

Digital Footprint Bingo

### Duration:

15 minutes

### Objective:

To get participants familiar with one another by exploring their digital experiences, fostering interaction, and creating a comfortable environment for collaboration throughout the workshop.

### Materials Needed:

- Bingo Cards: Each card should have a 5x5 grid. In each box, list a digital experience or task (examples below).
- Pens/Markers: For participants to mark their cards.
- Small Prize: For the winner (optional).

- Used a video conferencing tool (e.g., Zoom)
- Downloaded an app for work
- Created an infographic

### Instructions:

1. Distribute the Bingo cards to each participant as they arrive.

2. Explain the Rules:

- Participants must mingle and ask each other if they've completed any of the tasks listed on the card.
- When they find someone who has completed a task, that person must sign the corresponding box.
- The goal is to complete a row, column, or diagonal of signatures on the Bingo card.
- Participants can only sign one box per card (to ensure they talk to multiple people).

### Completion:

The first person to complete a row, column, or diagonal yells "Bingo!" and wins a small prize (optional). After the game, briefly discuss some interesting digital experiences participants have shared.

### **Debrief:**

Ask the winner (and a few others) to share a fun or unexpected digital experience they've had. Highlight the diversity of digital experiences in the room, emphasizing the relevance of the upcoming workshop topics.
