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## TRAINING CURRICULUM FOR COMPETENCE: CITIZENSHIP

### Aim of the workshop

The aim of this workshop is to provide participants with a deep understanding of the multifaceted nature of citizenship, exploring its fundamental components, including legal status, rights, and responsibilities. The lesson will emphasize the evolving concepts of sexual and cultural citizenship, highlighting how identity, gender, and cultural diversity shape individual and collective experiences within society. Through critical analysis of inclusive and exclusive policies, participants will gain skills in assessing the impact of these policies on different groups. Ultimately, the lesson will foster a commitment to inclusivity, encouraging participants to respect and support diverse identities and actively engage in building cohesive, inclusive communities.

### Learning outcomes

After the end of the workshop, the participants will be in a position to:

***In terms of knowledge:***

- *Recognize the fundamental components of citizenship, including legal status, civic rights, and responsibilities, and how these elements contribute to social cohesion and individual identity within a community.*
- *Understand the concept of sexual citizenship, including its evolution from intimate citizenship, and the significance of integrating identity and sexuality within the framework of citizenship rights.*
- *Understand the role of cultural identity in shaping both personal and collective citizenship, recognizing how diverse identities contribute to a shared community.*

- *Apply critical thinking to analyse diverse forms of political and civic participation, including voting, community service, and advocacy, to support a more engaged and inclusive society.*
- *Demonstrate the ability to engage in discussions about gendered and sexual citizenship with respect for diverse perspectives, and apply critical thinking to analyze policies affecting sexual and gender-based rights.*
- *Develop the ability to critically analyze inclusive and exclusive citizenship policies and assess their impact on the integration and participation of cultural minorities within society.*

- *Demonstrate responsibility in fostering inclusivity by respecting diverse perspectives.*
- *Exhibit responsibility in promoting inclusivity by respecting others' identities and rights within personal and public interactions, ensuring all interactions are consensual, non-exploitative, and foster a safe environment for diverse identities.*
- *Demonstrate a commitment to promoting inclusivity by respecting cultural differences, fostering mutual understanding, and encouraging active participation of diverse groups in civic life.*
