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TRAINING CURRICULUM FOR COMPETENCE: CITIZENSHIP

Aim of the workshop

The aim of this workshop is to deepen participants' understanding of citizenship by examining its core elements and their influence on societal harmony. Participants will explore how cultural diversity intersect with citizenship, affecting individuals' rights and participation in society. Through critical analysis, they will assess the impact of inclusive and exclusive policies on marginalized groups, developing strategies to promote equity. The unit also seeks to foster a commitment to inclusivity, encouraging active civic engagement and respect for diverse perspectives within various social contexts.
