

## Icebreaker: "Virtual Scavenger Hunt"

**Duration:** 15-20 minutes

**Objective:** To energize participants, encourage interaction, and add a fun, lighthearted start to the session by engaging them in a quick-paced virtual scavenger hunt.

### Materials Needed:

1. **Online Meeting Platform** (Zoom, Microsoft Teams, Google Meet, etc.).
2. **List of items/tasks** for participants to find or complete.
3. **Chat box or polling feature** (for responses).

### Instructions:

#### 1 Explain the Rules (3 minutes):

- The facilitator will call out an item or task, and participants must **find it in their home/workspace** and bring it to the camera OR type their response in the chat.
- The first person to show or type the correct answer earns a point.
- Optional: Use **breakout rooms** for teams to compete together.

#### 2 Scavenger Hunt Items (10 minutes):

- Find something **red** in your space.
- Show the **oldest piece of technology** you own.
- Find an item that **you use daily but never really think about**.
- Show your **favorite coffee mug or drink container**.
- Find **something related to your work or hobby**.
- Type the **last emoji you used** in the chat.
- Take a quick selfie and upload it to the chat (optional).

#### 3 Wrap-Up (5 minutes):

- **Congratulate the top participants** (if scoring).
- Ask a few participants to **share a fun fact** about one of the objects they found.
- Transition to the main session with a **positive, high-energy vibe**.

## Expected Outcomes:

- **Engagement Boost:** Encourages movement and interaction.
- **Personal Connection:** Helps participants share a bit about themselves in a light, fun way.
- **Icebreaker for All Levels:** Works for both introverts and extroverts since they can participate in different ways (showing objects or typing responses).
